

Advanced Riders FAQ

What is the schedule like?

Advanced Riders Camp is perfect for all serious horse lovers! Campers will spend their week at the ranch, and will be assigned a camp horse that they will be in charge of caring for. During the day, they will rotate through activities such as, unmounted, mounted lessons, trail rides, and ranch chores. One night during their week, weather permitting, campers will ride their horses to a horse pasture for an overnight camp-out!

What is the ranch staff to camper ratio?

In the arena, there is typically one ranch counselor for every five campers. On the trails, there are at least one counselor for every four campers!

Is my camper allowed to bring their own helmet?

Your camper may bring their own equestrian helmet as long as it is a current SEI/ATSM helmet, or borrow one of ours. You do not have to purchase your own helmet for camp, we have plenty for everyone. All of our helmets are up to date SEI/ATSM certified.

What are the age requirements for Ranch Camp?

Our Advanced Camp is for campers 12- 15 years old.

Does my camper need to have previous horse experience?

Yes! Since our advanced camp program is geared towards campers with more equestrian experience, clearance from our Ranch Program Director is needed before signing your camper up. We believe this is a great goal to work towards while coming to camp!

What are their sleeping arrangements?

Our Advanced Camp campers will all stay in a camp cabin with their ranch counselors. Will my Equine camper get to do other camp activities?

Yes! Each day, there will be a designated time for our Equine campers to do other camp activities such as the pool, time on the lakefront and ropes course!
