

Equine Adventure FAQs

What is the schedule like?

Our Equine Adventure camp is perfect for all horse lovers! Campers will spend their week at the ranch, and will be assigned a camp horse that they will be in charge of caring for. During the day, they will rotate through activities such as, unmounted, mounted lessons, trail rides, and ranch chores.

What is the ranch staff to camper ratio?

In the arena, there is typically one ranch counselor for every five campers.

Is my camper allowed to bring their own helmet?

Your camper may bring their own equestrian helmet **as long as it is a current SEI/ATSM** helmet, or borrow one of ours. You do not have to purchase your own helmet for camp, we have plenty for everyone. All of our helmets are up to date **SEI/ATSM** certified.

What are the age requirements for Ranch Camp?

Our Equine Adventure session ages requirements vary week- to - week. Please view our Summer Camp Schedule. The minimum age is always at least 9.

Does my camper need to have previous horse experience?

No! Our Equine Adventure program is fit for those who are new beginners in addition to those who have previous horseback riding experience. Campers will be separated in the arena based on their experience, but will all ride together on the trails.

What are their sleeping arrangements?

Our Equine Adventure campers will stay in camp cabins with their ranch counselors.

Will my Equine Adventure camper get to do other camp activities?

Yes! Each day, there will be time for our Equine Adventure campers to do other camp activities such as archery, swimming in our lake, and crafts!
