

OVERNIGHT PROGRAMS PACKING LIST

We recommend that you pack your camper's belongings in a large Rubbermaid-type tote box. This makes it easy for campers to keep their things together and easy for parents to clean out when they come home!

Clearly mark items with camper's name; this will help in finding lost items. Limited lost items are kept for two weeks and then are donated to charity.

- Shorts - Enough for each day plus a few extras.
- T-shirts- enough for each day plus a few extras
- Sleepwear
- Underwear and socks- enough for each day at camp plus a few extras
- Raincoat
- Sweatshirt/jacket
- Long pants - for cooler times of day and any horseback riding
- Ranch Programs- long pants for each day at the barn and boots with a heel.
- Laundry bag
- Bedding-Sleeping bag or blanket, fitted sheet (twin) and pillow
- Water bottle
- Shower articles - Bath towel, wash cloth or sponge, soap in a container, shampoo/conditioner, toothbrush & toothpaste, lotion, brush or comb and shower shoes
- Shoes - two pairs of gym shoes, one pair old enough to wade in creek. Ropes course and Ranch require closed-toe shoes
- Bathing suits- One or two suits and two beach towels
- Sunscreen - When you send sunscreen with your campers please encourage them to be responsible about reapplying throughout their week at camp.
- Medication - In the original labeled container, medications are to be given to the nurse during Check-In. Special blister packs will be provided at check-in. Epi-pens and Inhalers can be carried by campers or staff but must be logged with the nurse. The nurse recommends you send an extra inhaler/epi-pen as backup to be kept in the health center.
- Commonly-brought items - Stationery, pre-stamped and addressed envelopes, flashlight, small battery-operated fan, backpack, disposable camera, snacks, personal hand sanitizer.

PROHIBITED ITEMS

- ⊘ ELECTRONIC SCREENS OR WIFI-ENABLED PRODUCTS (including but not limited to cell phones, game devices like nintendo DS or PSP, digital or video Cameras, ipods or music players, smart watches, fitness trackers, tablet or ipad)
- ⊘ EXTENSION CORDS (prohibited by the Fire Department unless equipped with a surge protector)
- ⊘ CASH
- ⊘ MATCHES/LIGHTERS/FIREWORKS
- ⊘ POCKET KNIVES
- ⊘ ALCOHOL, TOBACCO/VAPING PRODUCTS, ILLEGAL DRUGS OR INTOXICANTS
- ⊘ EXPENSIVE ITEMS (clothes, shoes, jewelry, smart watches, etc)
